Design Highlights

Heavy pine beams hold the structure in place with custom 1/2" steel brackets.

Custom finishes are used throughout the home, and it features a complex roof design. Great room walls are 18' high.

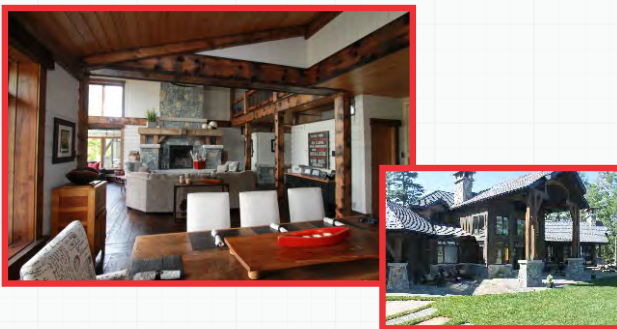


Construction Facts

This first-time ICF installation for the builder was completed in only 140 days during a long, cold winter.

Extensive blasting was required and many footing steps involved up to a total of about 10' in grade change.

The main level footings were pinned to bedrock.



Resilience, Sustainability & Comfort Notes

- Radiant floor heating was used throughout the home, making extensive use of Heat-Sheet™ radiant floor panels.
- Enviroshake shingles were used on the roof.
- An R25 air-tight Logix building envelope was specified.
